

CALP Final Report Tip Sheet - In Kind Contributions

This tip sheet is provided to guide CALP practitioners as they fill in the In-Kind Contributions section of the CALP Final Report (Section G. Evaluation – Outcome 3.2b).

This measure is tracking the approximate total in-kind contributions of time, services or products (in dollars) contributed from external organizations to the delivery of CALP-funded programs and projects

Accurately reflecting the in-kind contributions your CALP receives is important as it is one way to capture your CALP's engagement with the community and the support you receive. It also helps your board understands the financial implications and benefits these contributions bring to your organization.
