

What is new about Numeracy in the CALP Guidelines 2020

Below is a list of changes in Numeracy in the [CALP Guidelines 2020](#) (Section 5.1.2. p 26)

Definition and primary intended learning objectives

In addition to the requirements in sections 5 and 5.1, grant recipients are also required to consider the following information. Numeracy is defined in the Community Adult Learning Program Guidelines as the ability to use, apply, interpret, and communicate mathematical information and ideas.

The primary intended learning objective of learning opportunities in this category should be using numbers and thinking in quantitative terms to complete tasks, up to and including a pre-GED level.

Learning opportunities in numeracy may support the development of several skills for success from the forthcoming Canada's Skills for Success Framework—primarily numeracy but, in addition, may include problem-solving and adaptability.
