



## Links to Young Adult Employment (Alberta)

This employment bridging program, delivered virtually Alberta wide, supports professionally trained immigrant mothers seeking employment. Participants benefit from digital skills training, placements, and individualized employment counselling.

### This program offers:

- 4 weeks of paid pre-employment skill-building training
- 8 weeks of paid Canadian work experience
- Computer skills enhancement and job search support
- English language enhancement
- One-on-one employment counselling and career planning support
- Individualized labor market assessment and action plan
- Compensation for childcare costs

### Eligibility criteria:

- Mothers between 15-30 years of age
- Permanent Residents, refugees and citizens
- Unemployed or underemployed
- Canadian Language Benchmarks (CLB) 5 or higher
- Individuals receiving EI or non-EI
